



A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER COUNTY REPUBLICAN EXECUTIVE
COMMITTEE REGARDING COURT PACKING

*Passed unanimously by the Collier County Republican Executive Committee
May 3, 2021*

WHEREAS, Court Packing is defined as adding seats to the Supreme Court of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the United States has had nine seats since 1869; and

WHEREAS, Court Packing was attempted in 1937 by President Franklin Delano Roosevelt and rejected for its severe partisan impact and destruction of the checks and balance system; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the United States is part of the Judiciary which is an independent, apolitical branch; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the United States must interpret the United States Constitution free of political influence; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court is the only branch as of 2021 that puts law and order above political whims; and

WHEREAS, Court Packing is a solely partisan attempt by the radical leftists to gain totalitarian control of all three branches of government; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Collier County Republican Executive Committee demand that the President, Vice President and all Representatives in the House and Senate refuse to consider Court Packing the Supreme Court and deny bringing any Court Packing legislation to the floor; and

THAT, if such legislation is brought forward in committee or to the floor, all Representatives in the House and Senate vote against it; and

THAT, the President not sign any Executive Orders that furthers Court Packing; and

THAT, the President and Vice President terminate the commission researching the potential of Court Packing.
