



A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER COUNTY REPUBLICAN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE IN
SUPPORT OF THE CUBAN PEOPLE SEEKING LIBERTY AND DEMANDING THE BIDEN
ADMINISTRATION CONDEMN CUBA'S CORRUPT COMMUNIST DICTATORSHIP

Passed by the Collier County Republican Executive Committee – August 2, 2021

WHEREAS, Fidel Castro took over Cuba in 1959; and

WHEREAS, Cuba has been a Communist nation since Castro's takeover and a referendum published in 2019 reaffirmed this stating that the Communist Party of Cuba is the "leading force of society and of the state;" and

WHEREAS, the Cuban people have since suffered under the Communist regime; and

WHEREAS, the Cuban people have suffered human rights abuses including torture, arbitrary imprisonment, unfair trials, and extrajudicial executions;

WHEREAS, the Cuban people are deprived of their basic human rights; and

WHEREAS, there have been recent protests by the Cuban people demanding freedom even under the new President Miguel Diaz-Canal; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the CCREC supports the Cuban people's calls for freedom from the Communist dictatorship (or "non-Democratic authoritarian regime");

AND, that the Biden administration must recognize that the Cuban people must be free of the oppression of Communist/Socialist leadership that has plagued Cuba for the last 62 years.
