



A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLIER COUNTY REPUBLICAN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
TO IMPEACH PRESIDENT JOSEPH R BIDEN

Passed by the Collier County Republican Executive Committee – September 13, 2021

WHEREAS, an impeachable offense is Treason against the United States; and

WHEREAS, an element of Treason is to intentionally “giv[e] aid or comfort to the government’s enemies;” and

WHEREAS, Joe Biden created a foreseeable and preventable crisis in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Biden acted with flagrant disregard for American life in Afghanistan and flagrant disregard for the life of Afghan allies to the United States; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s actions in removing US troops from Afghanistan was done haphazardly and only with the purpose of political expediency; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s actions in removing US troops from Afghanistan so haphazardly was a dereliction of duty; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s cooperation with the Taliban was against US interest, resulted in the death of 13 US Troops through the suicide bombing in Kabul, and the abandonment and stranding of American citizens in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s actions have resulted in Taliban victory in Afghanistan and undermined the efforts of US troops to uphold American values; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s actions have resulted in the resurgence of the terrorist threat that resulted in the September 11th attack in the US; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s intentional actions have given aid and comfort to the Taliban, a known enemy of the United States; and

WHEREAS, members of the Democrat party impeached President Trump twice, despite not reaching the threshold of high crime or misdemeanor standard for either impeachment, thus lowering the standard of impeachment; and

WHEREAS, Biden’s treasonous acts meet the average standard of impeachment and certainly meets the lower standard of impeachment set through precedent of the two impeachments of President Trump; and

WHEREAS, President Biden’s actions imperil the lives of those women in Afghanistan who are our allies and who risked their lives to run for and to serve in office; and

WHEREAS, President Biden's actions have imperiled the lives of all women in Afghanistan by ceding control to the Taliban who implement regressive physically harmful actions against women's education, careers, and freedom to move about in society, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the CCREC calls on all United States legislators that represent the state of Florida, particularly the Republican representatives for Collier County (Congressman Mario Diaz-Balart and Byron Donalds) to co-sponsor the Articles of Impeachment of Joe Biden submitted by Representative Marjorie Taylor Greene;

AND, to submit new articles of impeachment immediately if the Articles of Impeachment of Joe Biden are not brought to the House Floor;

AND, to support all future efforts to hold Joe Biden and his entire administration (including Kamala Harris and conspirators to Biden's administration like Nancy Pelosi) accountable for their intentional efforts to undermine the United States' Constitution, values, and citizens.
